Our programs are based on the Ontario School Curriculum. Some of the many options we offer are:

#### Classes...

The Underwater World (exploring aquatic plants and animals with dip nets, buckets and field identification sheets); Forest Adventures (learning about local forests, secrets of trees, history of land use, and identification games); A Bugs Life (learn to sing like crickets, hunt like praying mantis and play exciting games based on insect movements) – All based on curriculum from Science, Social Studies, History, Geography, and Physical Fitness...

#### Leadership Teambuilding Activities...

Low Ropes course, Survival skills, Orienteering, Camp-outs...

#### Traditional Camp Activities...

Canoeing, kayaking, sailing, archery, sports, arts and crafts, swimming, field games...

#### Evening Activities...

Campfire, Creative Dramatics, Night Hike, Clue and other games...
