

# VBS DAY CAMP COUNSELORS

## **Purpose:**

The VBS Day Camp group will work to support 4 Ontario Mennonite churches (one church per week) to implement their summer VBS program through the delivery of a program developed by the VBS Coordinator. Since the program is in its first year, we are hoping that the VBS staff are keen to be involved in the development of the role.

## **Qualifications:**

Some musical talent (singing or instruments)

## **Terms of Employment:**

A one month commitment. One week of pre camp (June 20-24) plus two or three training and development sessions in March/April or May). NOTE: This will be a great opportunity and should provide a great learning experience. Considering this is a new initiative for SLMC, there will be lots of freedom to shape and develop this program.

**NOTE: We guarantee all VBS Team members an additional 4 weeks of on-site employment at SLMC.**

## **Responsibilities:**

Attended 2 or 3 training sessions in Kitchener during March/April or May.

Follow the schedule and curriculum developed by the VBS Coordinator

Work well with volunteers from host churches

Ensure the emotional and physical well-being of VBS campers;

Offer support, guidance and feedback to co-counselors in order to ensure that the VBS Team is effective, harmonious, and always seeking to improve;

Represent SLMC in churches and promote the benefits of summer camp experience

## **Scheduling Considerations:**

This position is Monday to Friday off-site. The VBS team will leave camp on Sunday mornings and spend Sunday afternoon - Friday noon in host city. The VBS Team will return to camp on Friday afternoon/evening. During the week, evenings are off and off-site housing is provided for the entire group.
