

WATERFRONT LEADER

Qualifications:

The Waterfront Leader will be able to plan and implement a program that gives campers an opportunity to enjoy sailing, canoeing, and kayaking while improving their technical skills and knowledge of safe boating practices. He/she will be able to competently rig and manoeuver a sailboat, canoe and kayak and teach these skills to campers and staff. A Bronze Cross or National Lifeguard Service qualification is required.

Term of Employment:

One month in July or August plus one week of pre camp (the week before Staff 0)

Responsibilities:

- work with the other Waterfront Leaders to
 - ❖ use a variety of resources (books, other staff, etc.) that will help them create a waterfront program that strives to meet the goals outlined in the staff manual;
 - ❖ plan sessions for cabins as required
- implement all planned programs
- ensure that the safety boat is tested each day and available for use at all times when campers are boating;
- keep the Canoe Hut clean and organized, and monitor the borrowing and returning of all items from it;
- ensure that all sailing equipment is stored properly beside the Sauna and in the Canoe Hut when not in use;
- maintain all waterfront equipment in good condition, repairing any damages when possible, or sending damaged equipment for professional repair;
- ensure that any camper going out in a kayak can competently demonstrate a wet escape while in the kayak (done during their swim test);
- ensure all policies for the dock area are carried out as outlined in the staff manual and/or communicated by the director team
- ensure that OCA standards are followed for sailing, canoeing, and kayaking.

Other Responsibilities:

- All resource staff participate in after meal kitchen cleanup
- In conjunction with the maintenance person, resource staff will take turns fulfilling basic housekeeping responsibilities as scheduled

Scheduling Considerations:

- All staff will work together to allow for adequate time off, including evenings and rest periods and sessions as required.
