Carpool arrangements will be assigned each day at the meetup point. For Part 3 (Hikes 7-10), a shuttle will be arranged to bring us in and out of the park.

Hike the entire Peninsula section of the Bruce Trail in a 3 part, 10 day midweek series of end-to-end hikes in September! Successful completion of the entire section will earn a badge through the Bruce Trail Conservancy. Distances and terrain will vary (range 13-22 km per day) and some sections will be strenuous and difficult with rocks and tricky footing.

Part 1 and 2 will be based from Silver Lake Mennonite Camp with food provided and carpooling arranged.

Part 3 accommodations in the Upper Peninsula will be arranged independently (suggestion: Mountain Trout Camp near Dyers Bay). Each part is registered for separately. ***Please note that Part 3 costs through Silver Lake are ONLY for shuttling and park fees for 2 days through the National Park. Accommodation must be arranged and paid for by each participant directly to Mountain Trout Camp or elsewhere and food will be BYO.***
